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Admission Steps and Deadlines

✓ **CASPA Application: Verified by August 1;** recommended to submit by July 1

Requirements

Undergraduate Degree

- 4 year baccalaureate degree from regionally-accredited institution awarded by August 1 of application year

Prerequisites

See page 1 for prerequisite courses. Notes:

- Current UNM course numbers are listed, with previous numbers showing in parentheses.
- Utilize UNM's Transfer Equivalency System at <https://admissions.unm.edu/future-students/transfer/transfer-equivalencies.html> to determine equivalencies. For courses not listed, compare course descriptions.
- Applicants may apply with one outstanding prerequisite course that is not yet completed at the time of application submission. A lecture prerequisite and its associated lab is considered one course. Only required prerequisites (not highly recommended courses) count toward the one outstanding prerequisite. This course must be completed by December of application year with a grade of "B" or above. This will not be calculated in GPAs.
- Minimum grade for required prerequisites is "C" (not "C-"). Minimum grade for highly recommended courses is "B-".
- Prerequisites noted with an asterisk (*) and all highly recommended courses must be completed within 10 years of application.
- Lecture + lab courses must be a minimum of 4 semester credit hours or 5 quarter hours. Lecture only must be a minimum of 3 semester credit hours or 4 quarter hours.
- Any courses in the areas of Writing, Literature, Public Speaking, or Linguistics (including English composition and writing courses) may be used to satisfy that requirement. This is the only prerequisite for which Advanced Placement credit is accepted.
- It is strongly recommended that no more than two prerequisite lecture courses and no prerequisite labs be taken online. Limits on online courses will be waived for courses taken during calendar years 2020 and 2021 only.
- All prerequisites and highly recommended courses must be taken for a letter grade. However, prerequisite laboratories only taken for credit (or pass) in calendar years 2020 and 2021 only will be accepted, though a letter grade is preferred if possible.

Grade Point Averages

- Science and Math GPA (all Science and Math courses within 10 years of application): ≥ 3.0
- Cumulative Last 60 Credits GPA: ≥ 3.0

Direct Patient Care Experience

- Minimum of 1,000 hours required at time of application

Community Service

- Recommended; not required

Letters of Recommendation

- 3 letters required, 2 of which must be clinical references
